

## **EVENT INFO**

### **What is the venue?**

Townsville & District Rugby Club, Hugh St, Currajong

### **What time does the festival start and finish?**

12noon - 10 pm

### **Is this all ages?**

Full Noise is a 15+ event. To avoid disappointment we encourage younger looking 15 year olds to bring school ID.

Proof of age will also be required for any patron wanting to consumer alcohol. See down below for acceptable forms of ID.

## **TICKETS**

### **How much are tickets?**

General Admission \$90 + BF

VIP tickets - \$125 + BF - SOLD OUT

### **Can I buy a ticket on the day?**

We can't guarantee anything so it's best you get in early to avoid disappointment. Subject to availability, tickets will be sold at \$110. Correct money may be required.

### **I've bought a ticket but can no longer go and want to give it to a friend, is this okay?**

Yes

**I have bought an 18+ ticket but now I can't go so can I give it to my U18 friend, and let them tell security they dont have I.D.?**

No, if you cannot show proof of age then you will be issued with an U18 wristband.

**I need to change the postal address I nominated my tickets to be sent to, who do I contact?**

**I think someone may have a copy of my e-ticket, what do I do?**

Contact Oztix immediately, if they enter the venue on the date before you we cannot re-issue you with another ticket free of charge.

**Will ID be required for Entry?**

Yes ID will be required for entry if you wish to consume and purchase alcohol. Acceptable forms of ID are: Passport, drivers license and Queensland Transport 18+ card.

**All patrons and staff will be wrist-banded on entry to the event. ANY patrons with no wristband that are on site will be ejected immediately.**

**Patrons regardless of age must have a valid ticket**

## **LINEUP**

**Has the line-up been announced yet?**

Yes, check it out under the line up tab.

**I am a huge fan of (insert Full Noise act) can I please go backstage for an autograph and photo after their set?**

No, you must have a backstage access pass to be granted entry. Your best bet is at the official after party at The Consortium.

## **ON THE DAY**

### **Can I leave the venue and come back in?**

No. There will be no pass outs.

### **If it rains do I get my money back?**

No, the event will proceed subject to safe conditions deemed by Vass Promotions. If it rains there is some shelter but not enough for everyone so you will get wet if you don't bring a raincoat.

### **Can I bring my dog to the festival?**

No dogs or other pets will be allowed on the grounds. Exceptions will be made for Guide Dogs and Police sniffer dogs.

### **What disability facilities are there?**

### **Will there be an ATM onsite?**

There will be several ATMs available, located throughout the venue, however to avoid queues, bring your cash along. Please see venue map for further details closer to the event.

### **Can I Smoke at the event?**

Yes, the event has dedicated smoking only areas within the event site. You may smoke in these areas only. Smoking outside these areas is not allowed and will result in a \$200 on the spot fine. No food or drink is permitted into the Smoking Only Area.

QLD Government stipulates that it is illegal to sell Tobacco or Other Smoking Products to a child (less than 18 years of age). It is also illegal for a person over 18 to give a person under 18 cigarettes or tobacco products.

### **Can I purchase tobacco products at the event?**

No, the event will not have a dedicated retail area selling this product.

**Can I bring along my own food and water?**

No bottled water or beverages of any kind is allowed to be brought into the festival. No glass or cans allowed. No food allowed. All bags will be checked by security and any bottled water or drink, food, glass etc will be confiscated.

**Are bare feet ok?**

No. You must wear shoes at all times. Thongs are allowed, however we do recommend closed shoes.

**Are there any dress regulations?**

There are no specific dress regulations, but in the event of sunny weather it is recommended that you wear suitable attire (i.e. wear a hat, bring plenty of sunscreen) and keep yourself hydrated.

**What items are not allowed at Full Noise?**

Glass, cans, skateboards, chairs (folding, portable, camping), angry personalities, anything studded (i.e. belts, wristbands etc.), weapons of any kind, fireworks, alcohol, illegal drugs, video and tape recording devices, professional still cameras (small still cameras ARE allowed), laser lights, umbrellas (bring a plastic poncho or a raincoat instead), water pistols, any other items considered illegal or dangerous and strictly no animals.

**Will Sniffer dogs be present at the event?**

Anything is possible. Full Noise does not condone nor will tolerate the use of illicit substances. Any patrons found in the possession of such substances will be removed from Full Noise grounds immediately and may be subject to police scrutiny. Don't bring anything that can be sniffed.

**Will police be present at Full Noise?**

Yes, there will be a strong police presence at the event

**18's or Over**

Please bring valid photo ID or you will not be able to buy a drink at the bar. Regardless of your age, if you do not bring valid Photo ID you will be required to wear an AGE NOT VERIFIED wristband preventing you from entering a bar area.

**15 – 18 yrs**

If you don't look over 15 years of age, please bring an ID. We don't want to disappoint you at the gate.

## **VIP Ticket Holders**

If you were lucky enough to get your hands on VIP tickets for Full Noise this year don't make your effort a complete waste by entering through a General Admission queue. Once your ticket has been scanned there are no changing wristbands!

Please note: the rugby club level 2 is a strictly NO SMOKING venue. Any patrons found smoking on the balcony will have their wristband swapped for a GA wristband.

### **How long will the VIP function run for?**

The function will run from 11am - 8 pm

### **What does the VIP area include?**

Short bar lines, Full – strength Beer, Cocktails, Exclusive drink ticket sales, Prime viewing of the main stage, Lounges, Your own d-floor with tunes spinning by local DJ's, Full flushing toilets, Eftpos facilities

## **MERCHANDISE**

### **Will I be able to buy band merch?**

Yes there will be an area where you can purchase a great range of band and merchandise.

### **Will there be Full Noise merchandise to buy?**

## **ALCOHOL**

### **Can I purchase alcohol at Full Noise?**

Yes, you will require an 18+ wristband to be eligible to purchase alcohol. You must present valid photo ID to receive your wristband. It does not matter what age you are, you will still be required to present ID. Please note we will be practicing the responsible service of alcohol and encourage you to have a drink and enjoy yourself, but if you go overboard we will have to escort you from the premises.

**If you are caught giving alcohol to a minor – this is a criminal offence and will be dealt with accordingly.**

### **Can I bring my own alcohol?**

No. Alcohol is not allowed to be brought into the venue. The venue will have several bars which you can purchase alcohol from. All bags will be checked by security upon entry and no beverages will be permitted.
